Surfaces and equipment are cleaned and disinfected according to the CDC guidelines



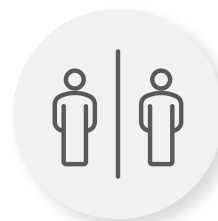
Social distancing and universal masking in all public areas
